The prime objective of this project is to ensure that women immigrating to different countries understand the fundamental concepts of financial literacy and management for executing daily tasks.

Financial literacy is the ability to understand and make use of a variety of financial skills. This includes processes like banking, budgeting, saving, credit, debt, and investing on which most of the financial decisions are based. Multiple barriers like unavailability of the financial information in the first language, lack of interpreter services, cultural indifferences/technical jargon make it difficult to approach the financial institutions and social exclusion make the situation worse for women to know about money concepts.

Within the project implementation, overall 2 Transnational Project Meetings (TPMs) and monthly Online Meetings will take place to ensure the project's proper implementation.

On August 30th 2022, the project's partners held their 1st online meeting and had the opportunity to get to know each other and organize the project's upcoming tasks. Moreover, they discussed project management and dissemination activities.
